I. Introduction to ARCOS

The Albertine Rift Conservation Society (ARCOS) is an international conservation organization with the mission to enhance biodiversity conservation and sustainable management of natural resources in the Albertine Rift region, Africa Great Lakes region and African Mountains through the promotion of a collaborative conservation action for nature and people (www.arcosnetwork.org).

II. The MuLaKiLa Project

ARCOS, in collaboration with the Government of Rwanda through Ngororero and Rutsiro districts, Reforest'Action, and Circular Bioeconomy Alliance, is implementing a Project named "Building resilience to climate change and sustainable agriculture value chains in agro systems around **Mu**kura Forest and **La**ke **Ki**vu Catchment **La**ndscape (**MuLaKiLa** Project)", under the financial support by AstraZeneca. The Project is the pilot phase of a Transboundary Regional Living Lab designed to improve resilience and adaptation in all mountain ecosystems and their communities in East Africa.

The project will build this resilience by restoring 21,000 hectares (ha) of smallholder farms through (1) the plantation of 6 million perennial trees (composed of 50% indigenous tree species, 30% fruits, and 20% exotic plant species), (2) the establishment of 2,450 ha of radical and 8,033 ha of progressive terraces, and (3) the improvement of the livelihoods of 160,000 smallholder farmers, over 30 years since 2023. In 2024, the project will build 800 ha of radical and 2,677.5 ha of progressive terraces. The MuLaKiLa Project will provide owners of the land where terraces are constructed with organic manure (compost), lime, and elephant grass (*Pennisetum purpureum*: urubingo).
